

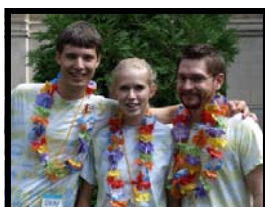
The 30th Annual Choir School Camp

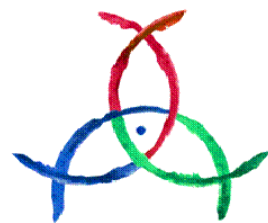
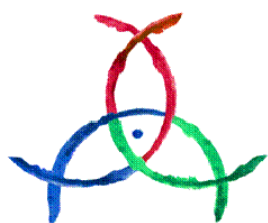
Grades two through five attend from 9am to 1pm daily.
